1. The number of credits for M.Tech Program shall be increased and give more credits to Project. It is resolved to increase the number of credits for M.Tech. Program from 70 credits to 80 credits and the project credits from 20 credits to 24 credits.
2. The number of credits for M. B. A. Program shall be increased. It is resolved to increase the number of credits for M.B.A. Program from 77 credits to 80 credits. For the Project evaluation, the internal and external component shall be 40% and 60% of the marks respectively for all programs. It is resolved to revise the internal and external component of project evaluation as 40% & 60% of the marks respectively and the same has been incorporated.
3. It is also resolved to invite the industry guide as one of the examiner for evaluation of project if the project is done at industry.
4. For promotion of B.Tech students from IV semester to V semester and from VI semester to VII semester, consider the 50% of credits up to IV & VI semester respectively. It is resolved to consider the 50% of credits up to IV & VI semester for promotion of B.Tech students into V and VII semester respectively and the same has been incorporated.
5. It was suggested to remove the time period constraint for Re-admission of students. It is resolved to remove the time period constraint for Re-admission of students and the same has been incorporated.
6. Change the CGPA for pass class of B.Tech. from 4.5 to 4.0. It is resolved to revise the CGPA for pass class of B.Tech from 4.5 to 4.0 and the same has been incorporated.
7. Use the word supplementary examinations in place of Makeup examinations and was suggested not to specify the time period constraint for conduct of supplementary examinations. It is resolved to change the word make up examinations with supplementary examinations and the same has been incorporated.
8. Remove the provision for transfer of candidates from the colleges of affiliating University and other Universities. It is resolved to remove the provision for transfer of candidates from the colleges of affiliating University and other Universities and the same has been incorporated.
9. Question bank shall be updated periodically. It is resolved to update the Question bank periodically.
10. It was suggested not to specify the time period constraint for commencement of spot valuation. It is resolved to remove the time period constraint for commencement of spot valuation and the same has been incorporated.

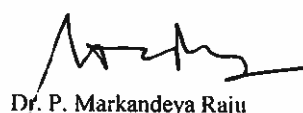

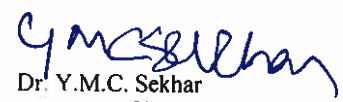
